2002 Gujarat riots: All 67 accused acquitted in Naroda massacre case



SIT court Thursday acquitted all 67 accused — including all 67 accuseu — maus BJP's former Gujarat minis

all 67 accused — including BJP's former Gujarat minister Maya Kodnani, Bajrang Dal leader Babu Bajrangi and VHP's ex-general secretary Jaydeep Patel — in the Maroda Gam massacre case of February 28, 2002 in which 11 people were killed as Gujarat burned in the embers of the post-Godhra riots. The acquittal, coming 11 years after the crime and 14 years since the trial commenced, was welcomed by 65 of the accused with claps and chants of "Jai Shri Ram" in the courtroom. They had been charged with 12 offences, including murder, criminal conspiracy, rioting and arson. Ahmedabad Municipal Transport Services chairman Vallabh, who was then a municipal councillor representing the city's Naroda Municipal Transport Services chairman Vallabh, who was among those on trial. Many of the accused, including Kodnani, broke down as special judge SK Baxi pronounced her verdict are acquitted of all the charges." They had been waiting on the court premises since 11am. Only two of the accused — Vishnuji Thakor and Jagdish Patel — weren't in the courtroom when the verdict came."

AHMEDABAD: The tragedy of human smuggling is the toll it takes on the children of the aspirational Indians ready to go to any extent to settle in the US. The extent to settle in the Us. The figures obtained from the US Customs and Border Police (USCB) revealed that as many as 1,109 unaccompanied children were found stranded near US borders between October 2019 and March 2023.

2023. Most of the children were between the ages of 12 and 17, said authorities, adding that the number of children found on the US-Mexico border was greater than those found on the US-grand border.

According to the US
Office of Refugee
Resettlement, unaccompanied children
(UAC) are undocumented immigrant children who come into the country without a parent or a legal guardian.

The USCB figures suggest a nearly eight-fold rise in UACs found on the US borders. In February 2023, as many as 14 kids, who did not have any documents, were found on the US border. While

Tound on the US border. While 13 were found wandering on the US-Mexico border, one was found near the US-Canada border. The figure rose to 104 in March, including 100 found on the Mexico border and four on the Canadian border. the Canadian border

According to the figures, as many as 219 children were found in the US in the financial year 2020. In Fy 2021, 237 unaccompanied children were found by the USCBP. The highest - 409 kids - were found in Fy 2022. As many as 244 children were found in the current financial year of 2023. The US financial year of 2023. The US financial year for 2023. The US financial year begins in October and ends in September. In a report published on March 1, 2022, TOI reported how human traffickers had hit on a new modus operandi. The criminals got adult migrants and children not related to them to pose as a family while crossing the border. If caught during the attempt, the presence of the children would ensure that they are provided refuge by the US government, Gujarat police had revealed.

"The adults and children undertake the perilous journey to the US-Mexico border. Before crossing it, the immigration agents pair one man, one woman, and two children - all unrelated to each other - to form a fraudulent family.

"If caught at the border, they present themselves as a family unit and seek asylum in the US. The American government sends them to a detention centre where the immigrants are given refugee cards. Ultimately, they get

citizenship with legal aid from attorneys there," said a police officer close to the investigation on human smuggling rackets in Gujarat. "The Mexico route is

"The Mexico route is much safer if you travel with kids. So, people are resorting to this method more than the Canadian one now, especially following the Dingucha tragedy," the officer added.

how Indians, mainly Guiaratis carrying young children, were undertaking perilous journeys walking through Mexico and scaling the razor wire fences at the Trump wall to enter the US. On December 14, 2022,

On December 14, 2022, a man from Kalol in Gandhinagar named Brijkumar Yadav fell to his death while typing to scale the Trump wall. He had been holding his two-year-old child during the attempt. Authorities later handed the child to the LIS Department of

'erroneous, unsustainable'; will challenge: Congress Surat : The Congress on Thursday termed "erroneous and unsustainable" a Surat court

"erroneous and unsustainable" a Surat court judgment rejecting Rahul Gandhi's appeal in a defamation case related to his "Modi sumame" remark, and said the judge seems "overshadowed" by the high order of the Prime Minister. Congress senior spokesperson Abhishek Singhivi said they would move the high court "very shortly" as the judgment is "fallacious" and contrary to all basic principles of law.

The court of Additional Sessions Judge R P Mogera rejected Gandhi's application for a relief against a magisterial court order sentencing him to two years in jall in the defamation case.

"A most unfortunate and unsustainable legal decision of the magistrate has

decision of the magistrate has been upheld in an even more unsustainable and erroneous judgement of the Sessions court given today. The conviction has been upheld contrary to all basic elementary principles of law," Singhyi told reporters at a press conference.

"Let me assure you that the judgement will be challenged in accordance with law in the very near future," he said.

Arguing that the judgment is "wrong" with no legal standing, he said the rourt has noted that Prime Minister Modi has been defamed along with 13 crore others with the Modi surname, which shows that the judge is "over-shadowed" by the evalled office of the Prime Minister. Sources said that Singhvi, himself a noted lawyer, is likely to appear before the high court in

We have several grounds to challenge the judgment. We will move the high court in the very near future," Singhvi said.

"We are confident that superior courts with

"We are confident that superior courts with constitutional power of judicial review, namely the high court and the Supreme Court, have the power and will set right the legal errors found in these two found in these two
judgments. We are clear that

reasoning," he said.

in a two-and-a-half page
speech "has been from

speech "has been from inception distorted completely out of recognition to serve the narrow ends of motivated complainants, that has been hardly interpreted in the sessions court judgement and what little has been said is a complete distortion legally erroneous"

been said is a complete distortion, legally erroneous'. Rahul Gandhi had on April 3 approached the sessions court for appeal against the lower court's order. Training his guns on the BJP government, Singhvi said, its "speed and zeal" to act after the magistrate's original order shows "they are notivated by political animosity from house taking to electricity disconnection to serving notices etc". Their completely misleading and displaced

Their completely misleading and displaced statements about the OBCs have backfired on them and

the entire community and the whole of India now see the BJP as using the OBC community for narrow and cheap political games, he

said.
"The voice of Rahul Gandhi is not to be silenced in the manner in which the BJP thinks it can do. The BJP has been in a sense from Mr Modi downwards to the

Modi downward to the government and the ruling party captured in a fear psychosis," he said, alleging the ruling party has unleashed lakhs of trolls against the former Congress president. "They sometimes threaten you with privilege notices, sometimes it is suspension, but they do not know the stuff Rahul Gandhi is made of. They do not know the stuff Rahul Gandhi is made of. They do not know the resilience of the Congress party. His voice will not be silenced because he speaks to the court of people.

"He did not speak anything which is remotely defamatory in this case ... he will continue to speak fearlessly in the court of the people. Clearly these pressure tactics from pressure tactics from defamation, privilege notices to not (allowing him) to speak in Parliament to suspension etc are intended to silence his strong, fearless voice on issues of misgovernance, on corruption, on Adani-gate etc." the Congress leader said.

After his conviction by the magistrate court on March 23, Gandhi was disqualified as Lok Sabha MP and he was asked to vacate his official A stay on the conviction

A stay on the conviction by the sessions court could have paved the way for his reinstatement as Member of Parliament. The lower court had sentenced him to two years in jail while convicting him for criminal defamation over his remark. "How come over his remark, "How come all thieves have Modi as the common surname?" made during an election rally at Kolar in Karnataka on April 13, 2019.
